

BYLAW 17- 392

VILLAGE OF DEWBERRY  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF DEWBERRY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION WITH REGARDS TO OPEN AIR FIRES.

GIVEN THAT the council of the Village of Dewberry considers it desirable to pass an bylaw providing for the safety, health and welfare of people, and the protection of people and property, and for such services provided by or on behalf of the Village;

The council of the Village of Dewberry duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1.0 Prohibited debris, as defined within the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act, RSA 2000, Chapter E-12, shall not be burned in any fire set within the municipality, whether permitted or otherwise.
- 2.0 Any bylaw previously approved by council of the Village of Dewberry pertaining to the use of fire to dispose of prohibited debris as defined within the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act is deemed repealed.
- 3.0 Should a section or part of this bylaw be found to be improperly enacted or ultra vires for any reason, then such section or part shall be regarded as being severable from the bylaw and the bylaw remaining after such severance shall be effective and enforceable.
- 4.0 This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final date of passing thereof
- 5.0 Any previous bylaw adopted by council of the Village of Dewberry pertaining to burning of debris is hereby rescinded. The balance of any said bylaw to remain in effect.
