**Village of Dewberry Viability Review Update**

The Village of Dewberry contracted a consultant in the preparation of a Request For Proposal from engineering companies to conduct the Infrastructure Assessment for the Village of Dewberry. ie roads, sewer, water

The request for proposal ( RFP) was placed for proposals on May 6 2019 with end date for receiving proposals of June 12 2019.

Once proposals have been reviewed and awarded the assessment can begin.

Water will see a 0.10 per m3 increase and  
Sewer will be 1.10 per month increase

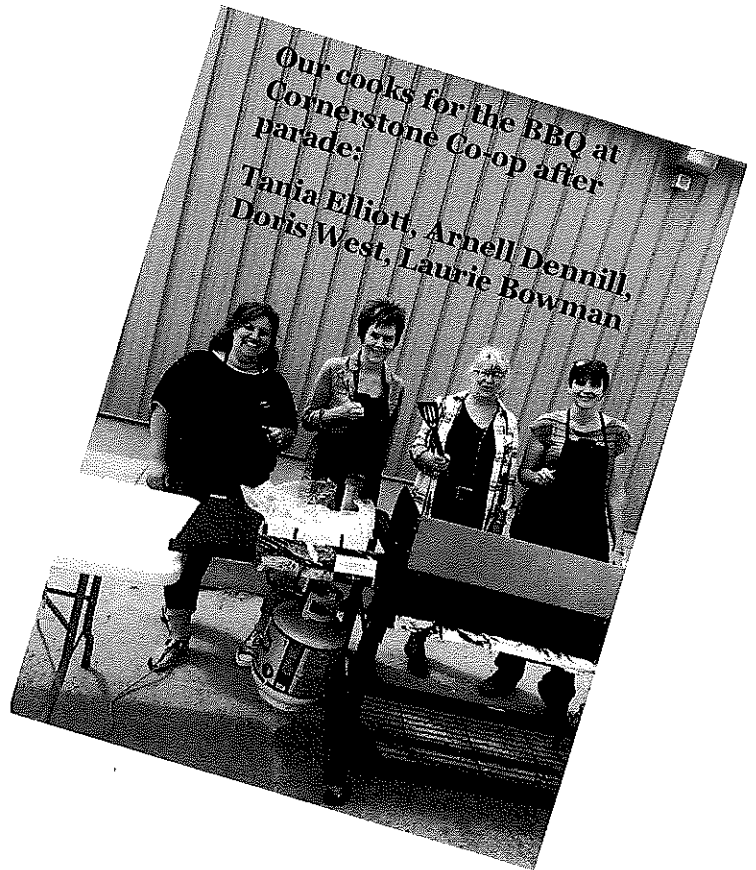

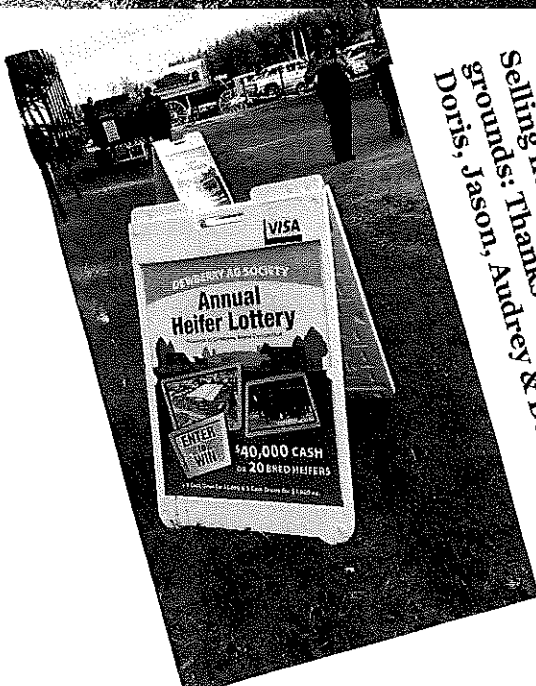

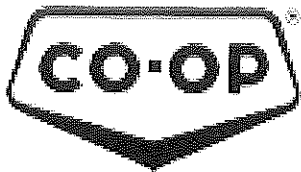
